
Door County's elderly, disabled, and/or low-income residents are the primary users of public transit.



Geography

- 2,370 square miles, 482 land, 1,888 water
 - Rural area
 - Largest city Green Bay –
 is 15 to 100 miles away...

...Depending on location within Door County



Demographics

- Among top 5 oldest residential population in WI
 - Significant concentration of disabled residents
 - Tourism & Hospitality
 - ✓ Seasonal employment
 - ✓ Lower wages = ALICE
 - ✓ Multiple jobs




History

- 2005 United Way performed needs assessment
 - 2006 steering committee assembled
 - 2007 governing council formed
 - Door County Community Foundation grant & other funding became available



- 2007 Website & resource guide
 - 2009 Received non-profit status
 - Half-price travel vouchers
 - 2010 County of Door launched Door 2 Door Rides
 - 2011 Door-Tran & County Veterans
 Services teamed up



- 2012 County-wide volunteer program
 - County expansion of D2D Rides begins
 - 2014 Vehicle loan program
 - 2015 Gasoline vouchers
 - 2017 Vehicle repair grants
 - 2020 Peninsula Transportation Coalition joins Door-Tran

 - Advance Notice






Volunteer Drivers

Vehicle Purchase & Repair Loan Program

- Bank of Wal-Mart
- Low-Income Households
- Tied to employment
- Ability to repay
- Terms & fees



Half-Price Gasoline Vouchers

- ✓ Temporary fuel assistance
- ✓ Tied to employment

✓ Income requirements



Vehicle repair grants

- Ineligible for loan program
- Income requirements
- Limited funding

 No-cost rides or fuel reimbursement for non-emergency Medicaid or BadgerCare appointments (must be eligible)






