# ***Geography***

- 2,370 square miles, 482 land, 1,888 water

# ***Demographics***

- Among top 5 oldest residential population in WI
  - Significant concentration of disabled residents
    - Tourism & Hospitality
      - ✓ Seasonal employment
      - ✓ Lower wages = ALICE
      - ✓ Multiple jobs

# ***History***

- **2005** - United Way performed needs assessment
- **2006** - steering committee assembled
- **2007** - governing council formed
  - Door County Community Foundation grant & other funding became available

- **2007** - Website & resource guide
  - **2009** - Received non-profit status
    - Half-price travel vouchers
  - **2010** - County of Door launched Door 2 Door Rides
  - **2011** - Door-Tran & County Veterans Services teamed up

- **2012** - County-wide volunteer program
  - County expansion of D2D Rides begins
- **2014** - Vehicle loan program
- **2015** - Gasoline vouchers
- **2017** - Vehicle repair grants
- **2020** – Peninsula Transportation Coalition joins Door-Tran

# ***County-Wide Volunteer Transportation***

- Travel within Door, Kewaunee & Brown Counties
  - Rider Registration
    - Fare based on household income
    - Advance Notice
    - Volunteer drivers

# ***Volunteer Drivers***

- ✓ Application, background check
- ✓ Valid driver's license & clean driving record
- ✓ Door-Tran provides driver orientation & ongoing training, mileage/meal/phone reimbursements

# ***Vehicle Purchase & Repair Loan Program***

- Bank of Wal-Mart
- Low-Income Households
- Tied to employment
- Ability to repay
- Terms & fees

- Fees vary



- Operated by County of Door
  - ✓ Wheelchair accessible
- Open Monday through Thursday

7:45 am to 4:15 pm

Fridays 7:45 am to 1:15 pm

- \$2.00 one-way trip within Sturgeon Bay
- \$2.00 two-way trips to ADRC meal site

*(must be eligible)*

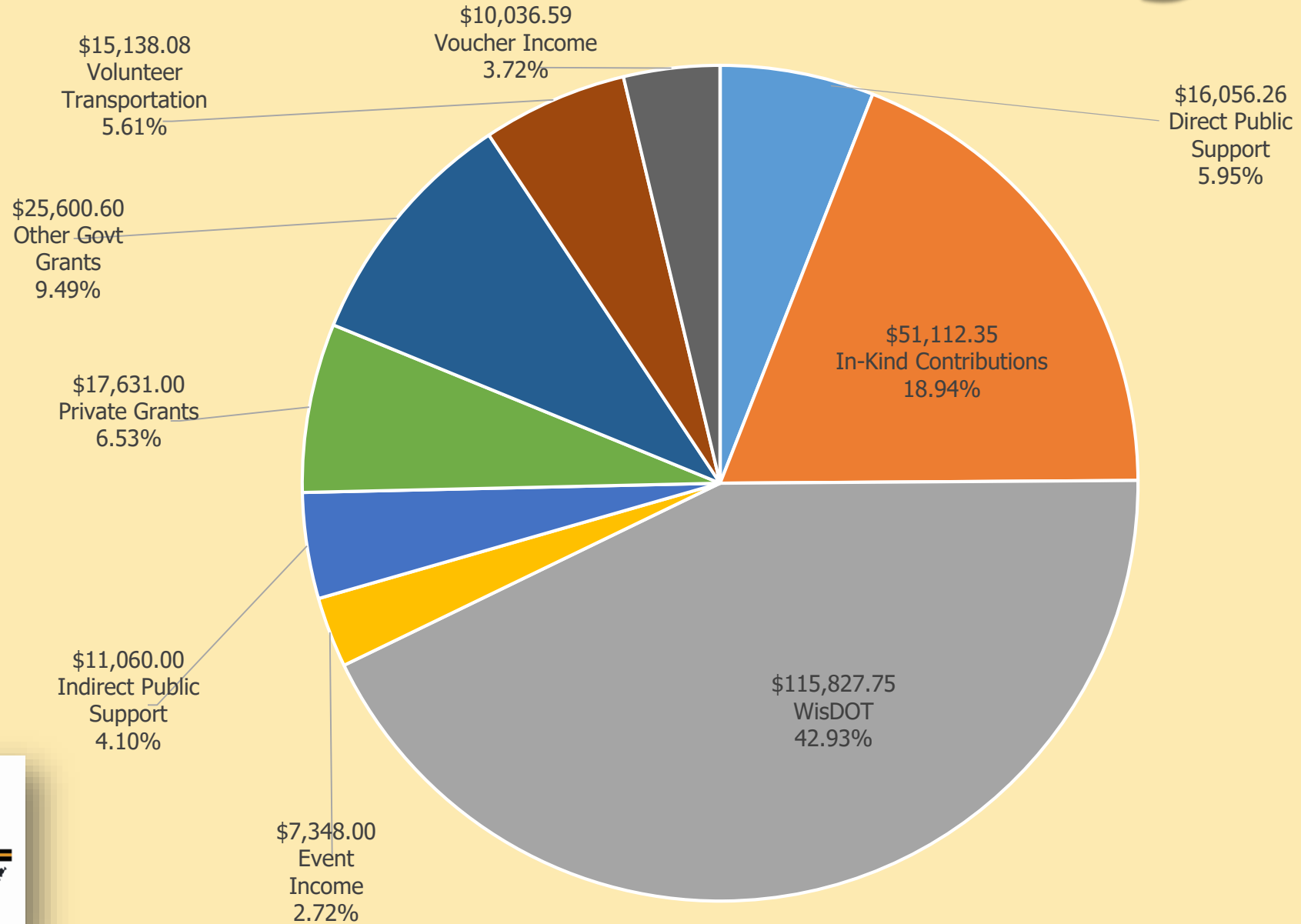

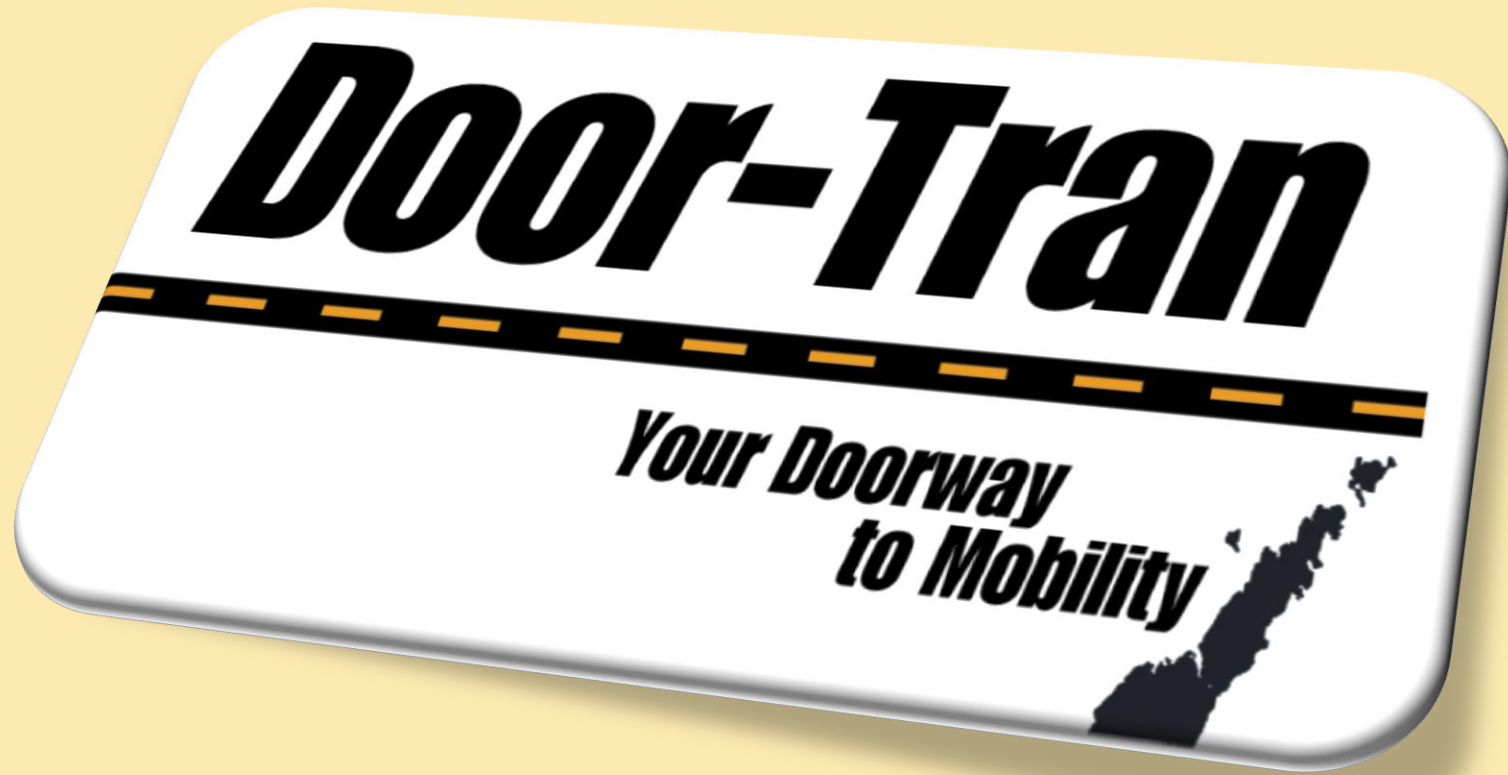
